In addition, BOEM will disable the Pay.gov Application forms from 5:00 p.m. Eastern Time, Friday, September 22, 2017, to 9:00 a.m. Monday, October 2, 2017. September 22<sup>nd</sup> is the final day for accepting payments.

Payments are to be made to BOEM through <a href="http://www.boem.gov/Fees-for-Services">http://www.boem.gov/Fees-for-Services</a> both before and after the blackout period. BOEM recommends that companies plan appropriately in advance of the blackout period.
